

# Crazy Quilt Class

In this class, you will be guided through the steps of making a small quilt block using the crazy quilt method. The crazy quilt patches will be sewn onto a 12-inch muslin base. The stitching can be done with either a sewing machine or by hand. Embroidery possibilities for embellishing the patchwork will be demonstrated. Examples of simple crazy quilt projects will also be available to view.

## Supply List:

- Sewing machine (optional)
- Sewing thread for machine or hand stitching
- Muslin square (12 inches)
- Scissors
- Fabric scraps from 6-10 fabrics, including left over quilt squares or blocks
- Embroidery thread, stranded and/or pearl cotton, or silk embroidery ribbons
- Other embellishments such as lace, narrow ribbons, yarn for couching or other trims
- Embroidery, crewel, or chenille needles

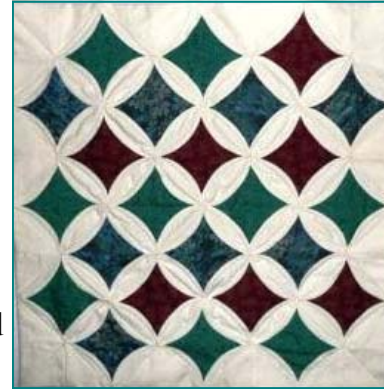
