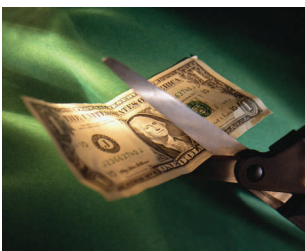

State Legislators may move to cut funds to Libraries by 50%!

State May Cut Library Funds! Tell Your Friends!

The PA State Senate is considering a bill that would drastically cut funding to Pennsylvania Public Libraries.

If this happens, there would be severe consequences for Elizabethtown Public Library. The following services would be eliminated:

- POWER Library
- Reciprocal Borrowing (Statewide Library Card Program) would be Eliminated
- Support for Interlibrary Delivery Service
- Virtual reference (Ask Here PA)
- Construction funds by eliminating the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation grants to libraries

AND, we would lose 50% (or more) of our state subsidy which is about 21% of our operating budget.

Please help Elizabethtown Public Library and the other Public Libraries in Pennsylvania by contacting your state representatives. Even a short note, email, or phone call will make a difference. Please ask at the Circulation Desk for a list of contacts or postcards and labels to send. Elizabethtown Public Library will even have them delivered in person if you give them to a Library Team Member.

If you would like to take greater action, please let us know. We can discuss some additional options for getting the word out.

Tee It Up Fore Your Library! on June 20, 2009

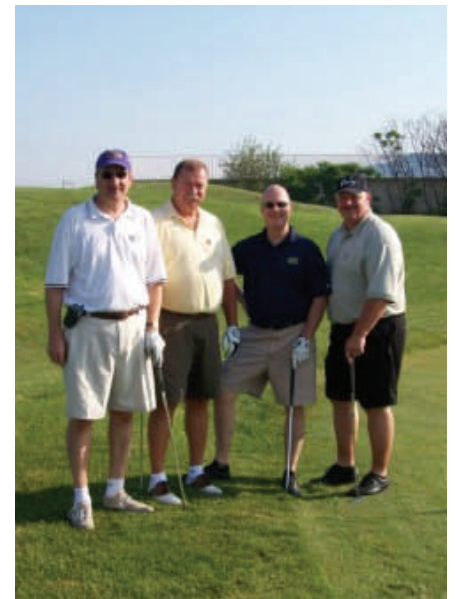
Special points of interest:
